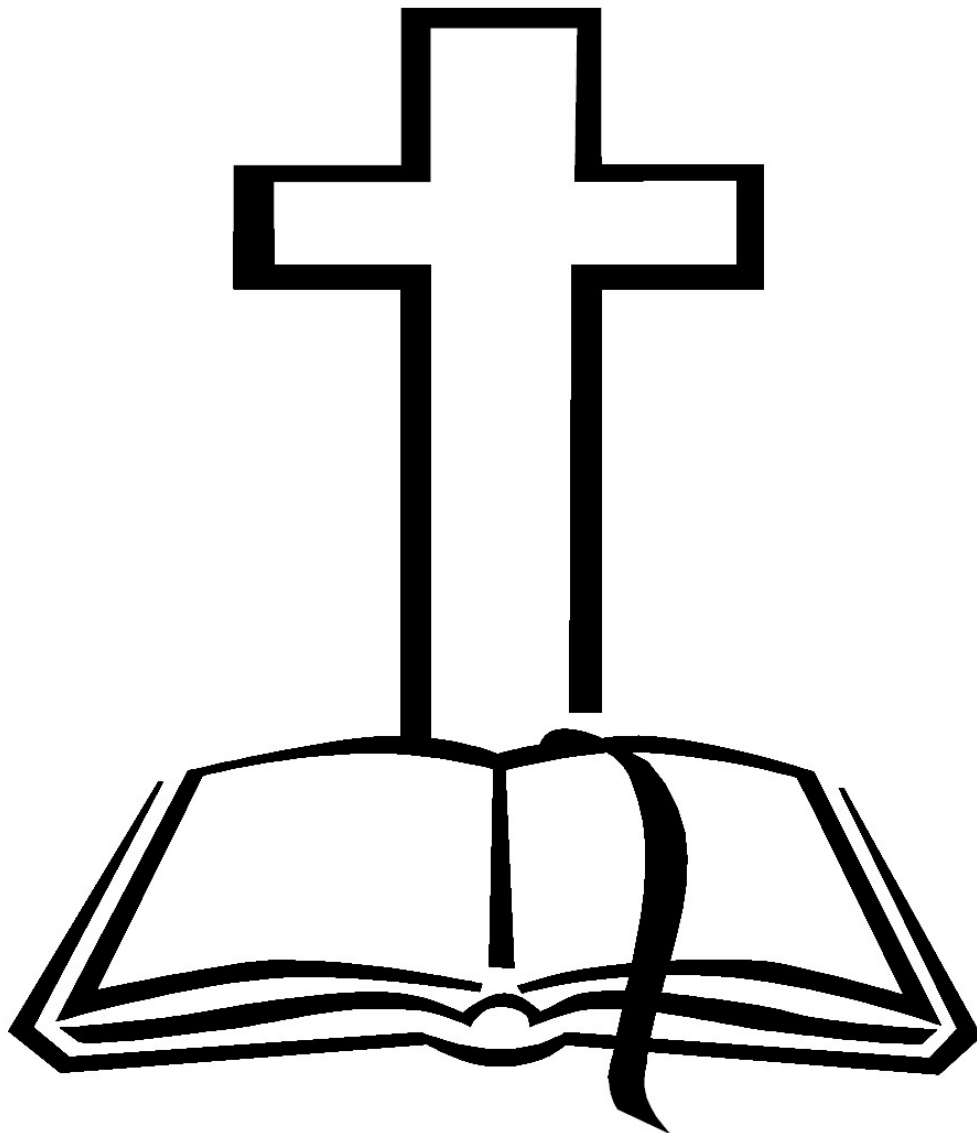


4th Grade Bible Memory Verses



4th Grade Memory Verses for Building Life Castles

1st Week: Matthew 22:37-39: Jesus replied: “Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’

L-01 **1 Corinthians 13:1** If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal.

L-02 **1 Corinthians 13:2** If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing.

L-02 **1 Corinthians 13:3** If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing.

L-03 **1 Corinthians 13:4-5** Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs.

L-04 **1 Corinthians 13:6-7** Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.

L-06 **Ephesians 6:1-3** Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. “Honor your father and mother”—which is the first commandment with a promise — “so that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth.

L-07 **Ephesians 6:4-5** Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord. Slaves, obey your earthly masters with respect and fear, and with sincerity of heart, just as you would obey Christ.

L-09 **Ephesians 6:6-7** Obey them not only to win their favor when their eye is on you, but as slaves of Christ, doing the will of God from your heart. Serve wholeheartedly, as if you were serving the Lord, not people.

L-10 **Ephesians 6: 8-9** because you know that the Lord will reward each one for whatever good they do, whether they are slave or free. And masters, treat your slaves in the same way. Do not threaten them, since you know that he who is both their Master and yours is in heaven, and there is no favoritism with him.

L-12 **Psalms 1:1-2** Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers, but whose delight is in the law of the LORD, and who meditates on his law day and night.

L-13 **Psalms 1:3-4** That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither— whatever they do prospers. Not so the wicked! They are like chaff that the wind blows away.

L-14 **Psalms 1:5-6** Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous. For the LORD watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked leads to destruction.

L-15 **Psalms 1:1-6**

L-16 **Philippians 4:4-5** Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near.

L-17 **Philippians 4:6-7** Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

L-18 **Philippians 4:8-9** Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things. Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me—put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you.

L-20 **John 1:1-2** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning.

L-21 **John 1:3-4** Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind.

L-22 **John 1:5-6** The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. There was a man sent from God whose name was John.

L-23 **John 1:7-8** He came as a witness to testify concerning that light, so that through him all might believe. He himself was not the light; he came only as a witness to the light.

L-25 **John 1:9-10** The true light that gives light to everyone was coming into the world. He was in the world, and though the world was made through him, the world did not recognize him.

L-26 **John 1:11-12** He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him. Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God –

L-27 **John 1:13-14** children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God. The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

L-29 **John 1:15-16** (John testified concerning him. He cried out, saying, "This is the one I spoke about when I said, 'He who comes after me has surpassed me because he was before me.'") Out of his fullness we have all received grace in place of grace already given.

L-30 **John 1:17-18** For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. No one has ever seen God, but the one and only Son, who is himself God and is in closest relationship with the Father, has made him known.

L-32 **Psalms 23:1-2** The LORD is my shepherd, I lack nothing. He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters,

L-33 **Psalms 23:3-4** he refreshes my soul. He guides me along the right paths for his name's sake. Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

L-34 **Psalms 23:5-6** You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Surely your goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

Additional verses:

John 10:27,28 My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand.

Proverbs 3:5,6 Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight.

Ephesians 2:8-9 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God – not by works, so that no one can boast.

Romans 10:13 For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.

Christmas Verse Matthew 1: 21 She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins.

Easter Verse Romans 10:9 If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.
