## START WITH Getting to Know my State project in packet

- Point out Video Tutorial at top of Project Page (just tell them to try it at home – will see how to cut and paste into a word document)
- State Directory Page → Getting to Know Your State
  - Can retrieve MS Word version from Website and do it on computer
  - How it Will Be Graded (Look at Rubrics online)
  - State Capital – **WY Wyoming Cheyenne**
  - State Nickname - **Florida**
  - Outline Maps – can print that and use for your hand drawing
  - Maps – can find details looking here – NC North Carolina
    - Page down to see topographical map
    - Notice Appalachian Mts
    - Not everyplace has Mts (Delaware for example)
  - Also see Maps from State Directory Page on right side menu
    - You can explore this
    - NEVER use COUNTY MAPS (with blocks of county names)
      - Info not important
      - Takes up space you should use for other things
  - Government Officials
    - Show the different links
    - Governor, Senators – Michigan
    - Demo cut and paste
  - State Flag – **AZ Arizona**
    - Click on one of the Get Flags for color or Color Me for outline if you want to color it yourself (you don't have to)
      - More for More Info about the flag (all kinds of info)
      - Show how to cut and paste
      - State Seal
      - **MO Missouri**
      - Cut and paste
      - If it tells what it means, include that.
      - Not all will explain the meanings of symbols like this one

- Put in your own words
- Don't forget **Parent Signature at bottom** – points taken off
- State Symbols **Stay with Missouri**
  - Click on Symbols at left, then select state -or-
    - Select State, then click symbols at left
  - Can click on picture shown -or-
    - Can do a Google image and cut and paste that
      - Do SQUARE DANCING as an example
      - Behind Text
      - Make bigger, drag around
      - Put a label next to picture with a text box
      - Be sure to save or you'll lose it
      - Can print these pages
- Point out tutorials
  - Working with Pictures (directions)
  - Copying an image in Word (video)
    - Crank up volume all the way.
    - May need to scroll up and down to keep pace with the mouse on the screen at times.
