

Mr. Shapero's Schedule of Periodic Assignments

The following schedules are mostly geared to students in my own homeroom class; however, the math portion below applies to students only in my math class, which also draws students from other 4th grade classes.

Please keep in mind that there will be times when schedules might change; for example, if there is a week when we're off on Fridays, I may do those things on Thursday, or I may eliminate a Friday test or assignment altogether. Be watchful of student planners and my online homework log as this information is the most up-to-date.

The following schedules are in effect most of the time:

BIBLE:

- * Students will say their Bible verses on Thursdays.

LANGUAGE ARTS:

- * Weekly Spelling assignments are due on Thursdays
- * Reading, Vocab, Spelling, etc. tests are given on Fridays
- * Written assignments (writing prompts) may be due any day – spread over a week or more.
- * Reading Calendars are typically due the first week of each month for the previous month.

SOCIAL STUDIES:

- * Tests may be given on any day of the week
- * Projects may be due on any day of the week
- * Homework, if assigned, is usually due the next time I meet with that class for social studies. I meet with my own class Mon & Wed, and I meet with Mrs. Hall's class on Tue and Thu.

MATH:

- * Homework is always due the next school day
- * Tests may be given on any day

Student Planners are updated Thursday afternoons when they copy the next week's schedule. Not all information is known on Fridays, so students are to update their planners throughout the week. Math homework is updated in the planner on a daily basis.
